# Do you remember?

**Burma-Shave** was an American brand of brushless shaving cream, famous for its advertising gimmick of posting humorous rhyming poems on small sequential highway roadside signs. Burma-Shave was introduced in 1925 by the Burma-Vita company in Minneapolis owned by Clinton Odell. The company's original product was a liniment made of ingredients described as having come "from the Malay Peninsula and Burma. Sales were sparse, and the company sought to expand sales by introducing a product with wider appeal.

Once the Odells went a bit too far by offering:

FREE-FREE / A TRIP / TO MARS / FOR 900 / EMPTY JARS / BURMA SHAVE

Arliss French, manager of a store in Wisconsin took up the challenge and wired Burma-Shave and asked where he should send the jars. The Burma-Shave people wired back: IF A TRIP TO MARS YOU'D EARN REMEMBER FRIEND, THERE'S NO RE-TURN. French was not put off and sent LET'AS NOT QUIBBLE, LET'S NOT FRET, GATHER YOUR FORCES, I'M ALL SET. The Odells then responded, OUR ROCKETS ARE READY, WE AIN'T SPLITTING HAIRS - JUST SEND US THE JARS AND ARRANGE YOUR AFFAIRS

Then the Odells started to find a solution. They discarded the idea of sending the winner to the Mars Candy factory and instead found a city in Germany, Moers (pronounced Mars) The company sent French and his wife to Germany to be honored by all 106 inhabitants of Moers and international media.

The word "burmashaving" is used in <u>Canada</u> to describe politicians holding signs and waving to traffic by the side of the road, a common sight during election campaigns.
