# SUE GRAFTON DIES

Sue Grafton died of cancer on December 28 at a hospital in Santa Barbara, California. The younger daughter of mystery writer-lawyer C. W. Grafton first married in 1959, aged 18, to James L. Flood, with whom she had a son and a daughter. The two divorced by the time Grafton graduated from college in 1961. Her second marriage was with AI Schmidt in 1962 but it ended with protracted divorce and custody proceedings over their daughter. She married her third husband, Steven F. Humphrey, in 1978.<sup>[10]</sup> They divided their time between Santa Barbara, California, and Louisville, Kentucky;<sup>[5]</sup> Humphrey taught at universities in both cities.<sup>[15]</sup> In 2000, the couple bought and later restored Lincliff, a 28-acre Louisville estate .



Two of her early novels were published (KEZIAH DANE and THE LOLLY-MADONNA WAR, in the '60's) before A IS FOR ALIBI in 1982 .. She co-wrote for TV programs such as "Rhoda" and "Seven Brides for Seven Brothers" and two TV movies based on Agatha Christie's novels To her, A IS FOR ALIBI, the first in the Kinsey Millhone series, "was a ticket out of Hollywood." She received three Lifetime Achievement Awards: one from the Private Eye Writers of America in 2003 (The Eye); second from the Crime Writers Association of Britain in 2008 (The Diamond Dagger): and third from the Mystery Writers of America in 2009 (The Grand Master). She won awards for B IS FOR BUGLAR (1985), G IS FOR GUMSHOE (1990), and K IS FOR KILLER (1994), and F IS FOR FUGITIVE. Her last novel was Y IS FOR YESTERDAY (Putnam, 2017), and her alphabet series has ended at Y because she did not allow any movies or TV shows or continuation sequels. She was 77.

Enjoyable and rather short. Buddy Steel goes to small CA town where his father is sheriff with Lou Gehrig disease Buddy Is to be acting sheriff and the case he solves is that of the missing wife of a local ministry mogul. Buddy is a wisecracking cop and fun to spend time with..

Turner, Ann - OUT OF THE ICE - 2016 - Antarctica - 4.25 Kindle

When environmental scientist Laura Alvarado is sent to a remote Antarctic island to report on an abandoned whaling station, she begins to uncover more than she could ever imagine.

Smith, Lachlan - BEAR IS BROKEN - #1 -2013 - San Francisco - 2.75

Leo Maxwell, new lawyer is lunching with his brother when the brother (famous defense layer) is shot in the head. Slow development as Leo decides he must find the killer and to finish the brother's active case.

Ward, Sandi - THE ASTONISHING THING - 2017 - 3.0 - How a cat named "boo" saved a family. Told from the cat's point of view. Cute

Heller, Peter - CELINE - 2017- 3.5 -East Coast various and Montana

Celine (70+) and husband in Montana to seek answers to Gabriela's father. Told in very disjointed flashbacks (perhaps due to being "read" on CD's)

Dyer-Seeley, Kate - IN CAVE DANGER - #5 - 2017 - Oregon - 4.0- Kindle

Writer for Adventure magazine Meg goes to Bend Oregon to follow a case involving use of lava cave for a meth import business. It's Oregon, it can't be bad.

# Littlejohn, Emily - INHERIT THE BONES - 2016 -Cedar Creek, Colorado? - 4.9

Detective Gemma Monroe catches a the case of a murder victim at a circus who turns out to have "died" three years earlier. Eventually ties into a 30 year old case of two young cousins missing and found buried recently . Gemma is pregnant and manages in the last 2-3 chapters to enter the home of the killer without back up... thus a lower than perfect grade.

Barrett, Casey - UNDER WATER - #1 - 2017 - New York City - 4.0

Drunk PI is hired to find a missing daughter. The PI is an ex competitive swimmer as is the daughter he seeks and her brother. First lead is to the coach the three have had. Many water illusions... many drugs injested by the PI as well as much beatings and torture. Well written but nasty piece of work. A grade that does not reflect my enjoyment which was closer to a 2.0

Tracy, P. J. - RETURN OF THE MAGI - 2017 - Las Vegas - 5.0 - Kindle

A charming Christmas story about a young black con-man who on his 23 arrest is sent to a community rehab program (at a locked in facility for mental patients) where he meets two old ladies convinced he is the third magi.

Shelby, Ashley - SOUTH POLE STATION 2.25 stars It was a book on theme. So I read it. The characters were introduced haphazardly, equipment used was named, but not explained. Lots of scientific jargon I did not understand. Also, not a mystery. Just like a journal of girl lost on her way to becoming a fulfilled person.

#### Delany, Vicki - GOLD MOUNTAIN - 3.75 stars

A woman with a checkered past operates a dance hall/saloon in Dawson, Yukon Territory in 1898. She has her 12 year old son with her. A man associated with Soapy Smith of Skagway has a treasure map that he is sure will make him the king of the Klondike. He kidnaps Fiona to go with him to search for this treasure. It is September in the Yukon and he is a city slicker, with no wilderness knowledge and Fiona is kidnapped in an evening dress. Question one: how will they survive? And question two: will her son and Corporal Sterling of the NWMP find her in time? A much better read than the first one I read. Charlotte Pitt's grandmother, Mariah Ellison, returns to a village she lived long ago to help her friend and her grandson to clear her name from gossip that she had killed her husband twenty years previously. A slow read that ends predictably.

Rollins, James - THE DEMON CROWN 2.75 stars Once again, as in all Sigma Force thrillers, they are called in to save the world. This time a wealthy Japanese capitalist is behind a plan to get back at the Western world because his wife had been killed during a robbery of a piece of amber from the Smithsonian. Huh? Yeah, that's the idea. This time using prehistoric wasps that can burrow into people and eat them from the inside out.

It was nice to have another set of villains. I was getting tired of all villains as being Muslim. This book did not hold my interest and I just slugged my way through, hoping for a quick end.

# MARIAN BABSON DIES

Marian Babson (real name: Ruth Stenstreem) died in mid-December in London, UK after suffering from dementia and weakening health. American-born Babson emigrated to England in the 1960's and wrote over 45 so-called "Murder-Most-British"-style mystery books. Her first novel, COVER-UP STORY (Collins, 1971), introduces Douglas Perkins and Gerry Tate, two public-relations men in London. REEL MURDER (Collins, 1986) is the first in the series featuring Trixie Dolan and Evangeline Sinclair, two aging actresses in London. She served as secretary to the Crime Writers of Britain and won the 1996 CWA Dagger in the Library. Her last novel was NO COOPERATION FROM THE CAT (Windsor, 2012), featuring Dolan and Sinclair. Most of her novels feature a cat on the cover. I do not believe that the cats play an active role in the mystery but are part of the narrative She was 88.
