DIY Craftapoolza Toilet Paper Roll Organizer

Supplies

Toilet Paper Rolls

(paper towel rolls work too!)

Cardboard Base

(Example: cereal box, cracker box, wood square)

Glue

(super glue, hot glue, tacky glue)

Scissors

Decorations

(acrylic paint, tissue paper, mod podge, washi tape, paint brushes, etc.)

Instructions

- 1. Take your cereal box and cut one side out. Draw a stand on it in the shape you like *(can be a square, rectangle, circle, or island)*.
- Optional: Decorate the stand.
 Mod Podge: Apply a thin layer of glue or mod podge to the stand. Place tissue paper on the mod podge. Apply a thin layer of mod podge over the tissue paper and let dry.
 Paint: Paint the stand using acrylic paint and let dry.
- 3. Cut your toilet paper and paper towel rolls to the length you want them to be. *Tip: may want to cut a variety of sizes*.
- 4. *Optional:* Decorate the cut toilet paper and paper towel rolls using either mod podge or paint.
- 5. *Optional:* Add washi tape to the edges of the stand and toilet paper rolls.
- 6. Place the rolls on the stand and arrange them as you like.
- 7. Glue down the rolls to the stand. If using super glue or an hot glue gun, press down for 10 seconds until the glue is dry.
- 8. That's it, your organizer is done and ready to use!
