#### **TEEN TUESDAY**

## DIY TERRARIUM



## MATERIALS NEEDED

- A clear glass jar, vase, bowl, or another glass container you have on hand.
- Small rocks or pebbles
- Potting soil
- Various small plants
- Spoon

#### STEP 1:

FILL THE BOTTOM OF THE CONTAINER WITH ROCKS OR PEBBLES. THIS CREATES A DRAINAGE LAYER SO WATER CAN SETTLE AND NOT FLOOD THE PLANTS. THE DEPTH OF THE ROCK LAYER WILL BE DEPENDENT ON THE SIZE OF THE CONTAINER (BUT AIM FOR ABOUT 2").



### STEP 2:

ADD SOIL ON TOP OF THE ROCKS/PEBBLES. BE SURE TO ADD ENOUGH SOIL SO THE PLANT ROOTS WILL HAVE PLENTY OF ROOM TO FIT AND GROW.

(TIP: SUCCULENTS & CACTUS PREFER CACTUS SOIL)



#### **STEP 3:**

NEXT, USE A SPOON TO DIG A SMALL WELL IN THE SOIL
TO PLACE YOUR PLANTS IN. ADD MORE SOIL AROUND
THE TOP AND GENTLY PRESS THE SOIL DOWN AROUND
THE BASE OF THE PLANT. CONTINUE THE PROCESS UNTIL
YOU HAVE PLANTED ALL YOUR PLANTS. (TIP: IF YOU
HAVE SUCCULENTS AT HOME, YOU CAN USE CLIPPINGS
FROM THOSE PLANTS!)



#### **STEP 4:**

ONCE YOU HAVE YOUR PLANTS IN, YOU CAN ADD SMALL ACCESSORIES SUCH AS MOSS (DRIED OR LIVING), TINY FIGURINES OR TOYS, GLASS BEADS, STONES, ETC. THIS IS YOUR LITTLE WORLD AND YOU CAN DESIGN IT HOWEVER YOU WANT!
