(bounce child on lap).

Hickory, Dickory, Dock

(tick tock arm)

(other hand "mouse" runs up)
The clock struck one. *(clap)*
The mouse ran down.
(run mouse down arm)
Hickory, dickory, dock.

Cuckoo Clock
