Toilet Paper Roll Flower Wreath

Supplies

Toilet Paper Rolls

(two rolls per flower)

String

(to hang the wreath)

Glue

Scissors

Paint

Paint Brush

Beads or center of flower *(optional)*

Instructions

1. Prepare the toilet paper rolls.
 - Using the sharp edge of your scissors, scrape off the excess toilet paper bits.
2. Paint your toilet paper rolls. It takes two rolls to create one flower.
 - Optional:* Paint the inside of the roll a different color than the outside.
3. Cut the toilet paper rolls 1 inch thick using your scissors.
 - You will get 4 and a half pieces per roll. Each flower takes 6 pieces so you will end up with extra pieces.
4. Repeat step three seven more times until you have enough pieces for 8 flowers.
5. Now it is time to make the flowers.
 - The petals need to be relatively skinny for all six points to come together in the center.
 - They're not going to meet exactly, so I ended up gluing them together at a point a little higher up on the sides.
 - **Tip:** Glue three pieces together or half a flower at a time. It is easier to hold three pieces together and then glue the two halves of the flower together.
6. Let the flowers dry.
7. Glue the flowers together to create the wreath.
 - Move the flowers around until they lay nicely in a circle and then glue together.
8. *Optional:* Glue beads or centers of the flowers to add a finishing touch to the wreath.
